

## **Wild Cow Milking Rules 2011**

- 1. Teams consist of a “Four person team” to include: Anchor, two muggers, and a milker.**
- 2. Western Attire Must be worn: Long Sleeve Shirt (Team Shirt optional), Jeans, Boots and Cowboy Hat or Helmet.**
- 3. This competition has a “Two minute” time limit.**
- 4. Cow will be haltered with a long lead rope, which the anchor man holds.**
- 5. Chute is opened and Cow is released...cow must clear the chute completely to begin competition (no mugging in the chute is allowed).**
- 6. The cow must remain and be milked while standing on all 4 legs (no milking the cow if she is on the ground).**
- 7. Anchor and muggers will hold cow while the milker milks her using a standard 12 oz. longneck large mouth bottle. Milker may pass the bottle to another man to run to the judge.**
- 8. The judge will pour the milk out, (at least 1 drop must exit the bottle).**

**9. The winning team and second place team from each performance that gets to the judge and has milk in the bottle earns the right to return on Saturday night for the Wild Cow Milking Finals.**

**Remember: The Winning team and second place team from each night will return for Saturdays Championship round.**

**The winning team on Saturday night will be awarded a Traveling Trophy, a Belt Buckle awarded to each team member and a \$1000.00 donation will be made to the winning teams Charity of Choice.**
